Minutes Previous Monthly Meeting:

Ron Charles made a motion to approve the minutes of March 14, 2018, with one correction. Motion was seconded by Carl Koenig and carried with 4 Ayes.

COMMUNICATIONS:

The March 2018 monthly collateralized deposit account information report was received from BNY Mellon Broker/Dealer Services.

Information was received from the New York Municipal Insurance Reciprocal about the "Drive To Survive" Seminar to be held in the Town of Chenango Town Hall, Binghamton, on Monday, April 30 – 8:30 am to 11:30 am. This seminar is for Municipal and Heavy Vehicle Operations, and specifically for the operators of large trucks and public works vehicles.

HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:

The Highway Department is hauling stone, making road patch, filling pot holes and sweeping roadways. Two trucks are having electrical problems which will be corrected soon.

The Town Board reviewed the estimates received for the Town Garage "Stand-alone Generator". Motion was made by John Hofmann to purchase the "Stand-alone Generator", with installation included, for a price not to exceed \$7,000. Motion was seconded by Carl Koenig and carried with 4 Ayes.
