

# OXFORD TOWN BOARD SPECIAL MEETING

The Special Meeting of the Oxford Town Board was called to order by Supervisor Alan Davis at 7:00 pm in the Village Hall for the transaction of such business that may lawfully come before the Board. The meeting opened with a salute to the United States of America flag.

Old Business:

At the June 25, 2025, special meeting, Superintendent Pinney stated that he is hopeful that the new loader will be ready by the July 9 regular meeting. He would like to surplus the old loader, miscellaneous signs, and two bumpers. Motion moved to surplus the items was made by John Weidman, seconded by John Hofmann; all approved.

New Business:

Supervisor Davis has accepted the insurance offer for the totaled pick-up truck for \$31,995.50 and was allocated to account DA5130.2. Superintendent Pinney and Supervisor Davis acquired prices for a new pick-up truck, as the one in Greene would not meet the requirements that the Town Highway Department would need. Motion to purchase a new truck moved by Ron Charles, seconded by John Hofmann; all approved. Roll call: Ron Charles, yes; John Hofmann, yes; Carl Koenig, yes; John Weidman, yes; Alan Davis, yes. The funds for the truck would be allocated to the machine purchase account (DA5130.2). Motion moved by Ron Charles, seconded by John Weidman; all approved.

Due to recent flooding on June 22, the Highway Department is experiencing emergency road repairs. Serious damage was done to roads, culverts, and bridges. Several roads and ditches are in need of trees and debris being cleaned up. Motion moved to approve emergency repairs by Ron Charles, seconded by John Hofmann; all approved.

Supervisor Davis has reached out to an Engineer to assist with bids for FEMA work that needs to be done on Rounds and Mertz Roads. Davis will discuss with the Engineer an estimated cost for these repairs.
